On August 10, 2022, the NIGC published its revised proposal for redefining Key Employee (KE) and Primary Management Official (PMO) with substantial amendments to 25 CFR Parts 502, 556, and 558.

These proposed changes are a direct result of the recent updates to the NIGC fingerprint processing procedures and the manifestation of CJIS compliance requirements.

We understand the rulemaking process was part of the 2021 tribal consultation series, and with this revision being a significant change, we are requesting that the NIGC consider extending the September 9, 2022, comment period deadline for an additional amount of time.
